Dear Parents / Carers

Thursday 2nd October 2014 is an important day for schools.

This is when the Department for Education (DFE) uses the number of children on roll at a school to set the school budget for the next financial year. This money pays for staffing, resources, assists in enriching our teaching and learning; helps us to part fund visits and visitors; maintains our buildings and computer equipment – to name but a few things schools have to spend their budget on.

This year the DFE will also be collecting information about how many Reception, Year One and Year Two children are having a school dinner. As you know, the government have said they will pay for every child in reception, year one and year two to have a school dinner. However, what they haven't said is that they are not funding it 100%. Using the numbers from Thursday 2nd October the DFE will contribute 80% of the total take up to fund these school dinners.

So why are we telling you this?

We have 58 children in reception, year one and year two

Currently about 50 on average are having a school dinner (86%)

If between now and the next census in January this figure remains the same then following the January census, the other 14% take up the offer of a free school meal, the school will be responsible for these costs. Dinners for one child per year is currently £448.50. It would not take long to pick up a large bill. Therefore on census day in October and again in January we really need 100% take up.

What to do next:

We would like to encourage all reception, year one and year two children to have a school dinner on Thursday 2nd October 2014.

On Thursday 2nd October 2014 the school menu will be changing to hot dogs, chips and beans with a biscuit for pudding to mark this very special day

We will have to do this again in January


