Improvement works around the school site

You will have noticed that we are currently having some much needed improvement work completed around the site. Firstly, the surface underneath the children' play equipment on the playground is being replaced. The surface had become distorted and uneven due to years of rain water running underneath and also moles digging beneath the surface. The groundwork being carried out will replace every layer of of the playsurface, including new mole guards, new soft play padding and new artificial grass. We are hoping that this work will be finished by next week.





We have also had the old, 1960's skylights removed from the roof of the Victorian building, above Mr Martin and Miss Cooper's classrooms. These old skylights were not only unsightly and not in keeping with the Victorian frontage of the school, but were also the cause of water damage in both classrooms due to the amount of rain water that would leak through. These have now been removed and the roof has been re-tiled.

Our attention now turns to our outdoor raised beds and garden space, which has become overrun with weeds and needs a thorough tidy and freshen up. If any parents have an hour to spare during the week, and are happy to get their hands dirty, please speak to either Mr Reynolds or Mr Chidwick. We would appreciate any help in the garden that you can offer.


