
### Friends Of Northbourne – Easter Competition!

## Suffragette Day – Oak Class Monday 13th March

On Monday, Oak Class became suffragettes and suffragists for the day! They made placards and sashes, learnt a song and some wrote speeches - all for a rally which was held in the school hall in the afternoon. The speeches were cheered, the children marched and sang with gusto, causing much disruption to gain awareness of their cause!





The pupils looked at how, despite the vote being given to women in 1918, and full suffrage in 1928, equality is still needed in many parts of the world today - including in our country. We finished the day sampling some sweet treats from Edwardian times - homemade shortbread, jam tarts and fudge we had made during the day in the classroom.

The children described the day as, "fun, exciting, memorable, inspirational and historically accurate."

#### Maple class - master chocolatiers!

On Thursday Maple class became the master chocolatiers of Northbourne as they created their own delicious chocolate eggs, just in time for Easter.

The children used both their scientific knowledge and their technology skills to chop, melt and blend different types of chocolate together, along with added ingredients such as honeycomb and dried fruit. They then used moulds to set their chocolate into egg shapes.
