Flu vaccinations - Available to all year groups - Next week, Tuesday 26th September



ACTION REQUIRED

The Kent Community Health nurses will be in school next week, on Tuesday 26th September to administer the flu nasal vaccine to our children from Reception through to Year 6. The vaccination is a quick and painless spray up the nose. Even if your child had the vaccine last year, the type of flu can vary each winter so it is recommended to have it again this year. There is no charge for the vaccine.

Please submit <u>either a YES consent or a NO consent</u> as the NHS will continue to invite your child to be vaccinated unless they hear from you.
