Accessing Remote Learning for individual pupils in isolation

Dear Parents / Carers,

If you have a confirmed case of COVID in your household, or you are awaiting a test result, and your child has to self-isolate at home, then your child will need to access the Remote Learning set by their class teacher.

Once there, navigate to Pupil Zone on the top menu bar and then choose Remote Learning from the drop down menu.

On the Remote Learning page you will see a link for each class on the right hand side of the page. Click on your child's class and you will be taken to a page with a Remote Learning weekly plan for each week of the term so far. These plans are uploaded on a Monday morning at the start of each week.

The learning activities in these plans follow the learning objectives that the teacher is delivering in class. The activities might be slightly different, but the learning objective is the same. On each weekly plan there is the expectation that the children complete a daily Maths lesson, a daily Literacy activity, a daily Phonics or Spelling lesson (depending on their year group), and then a selection of wider national curriculum subjects, including RE, Science, JIGSAW (PSHE), Outdoor Learning, etc.

Any pieces of work completed electronically can be saved and emailed directly to school for the class teacher: secretary@northbourne-cep.kent.sch.uk Alternatively, any work completed on paper or photographed, can be kept and returned to the teacher once your child returns to school.

We would encourage your child to supplement the activities on these weekly plans with the other online learning platforms that we provide, such as Mathletics and Purple Mash. They can also access the learning on any of the previous weekly plans to help consolidate learning from this term.

We will also email additional learning to you that the class teacher wishes your child to have, such as weekly spelling lists.

Your child's class teacher will also ring you during the week to catch up on how your child is coping with Remote Learning and to answer any questions you may have. They are very happy to chat to your child too!
