How to make a banana sandwich

Ingredients

- 1 banana
- Flora butter
- 2 pieces of white bread

Equipment

- 1 plate
- 1 butter knife

Method -

1. First wash your hands thoroughly with soap.
2. Next spread a thin layer of flora butter on your slices of bread.
3. Then peel a banana and cut it into even slices.
4. Then put the slices of banana on one slice of bread.
5. Place the other slice of bread on top of the other one and push down on it.
6. Eat.

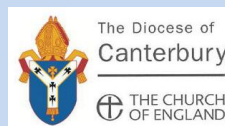
