<p>Topic <u>WALT To explore subject, verb, object.</u></p> <p>https://classroom.thenational.academy/lessons/to-explore-subject-verb-object-6ct3ar</p>	<p>Topic <u>WALT write a report about Pompeii</u></p> <p>This week the children will be researching and writing a report about the Roman city of Pompeii.</p> <p>In today's lesson the children will learn about the demise of Pompeii due to a volcanic eruption.</p> <p>Video link: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=YIZ4aSKT3mo</p> <p>Task: What do you think it would have been like to live in Pompeii in the days leading up to and during the eruption? Children to write a vocabulary list of descriptive words to describe the feelings of the people in Pompeii.</p>	<p>Topic <u>WALT write a fact report about Pompeii</u></p> <p>Children to write their report about Pompeii - this can be done on computer or paper and in any format. For example, you could create a PowerPoint presentation or Poster.</p> <p>What your report should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Where was Pompeii? • When did the eruption take place? • Who was the Roman Emperor at the time of the eruption? • Descriptive language to help show the emotion of the people of Pompeii. • What happened to Pompeii and what is it like now? <p>Links to help: https://www.dkfindout.com/uk/history/ancient-rome/pompeii/ http://www.bbc.co.uk/history/ancient/romans/pompeii_portents_01.shtml</p>	<p>R.E <u>Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'?</u></p> <p>Children to think about the following questions:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What events lead up to the Easter Story? • What key events can you remember from the Easter Story? • Why is 'Good Friday' such an important time for Christians? <p>Children to use the image from the Big Frieze attached.</p> <p>Annotate image with different information that you can see or know about the Salvation story.</p>

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Instructions for **Word of the Day**:

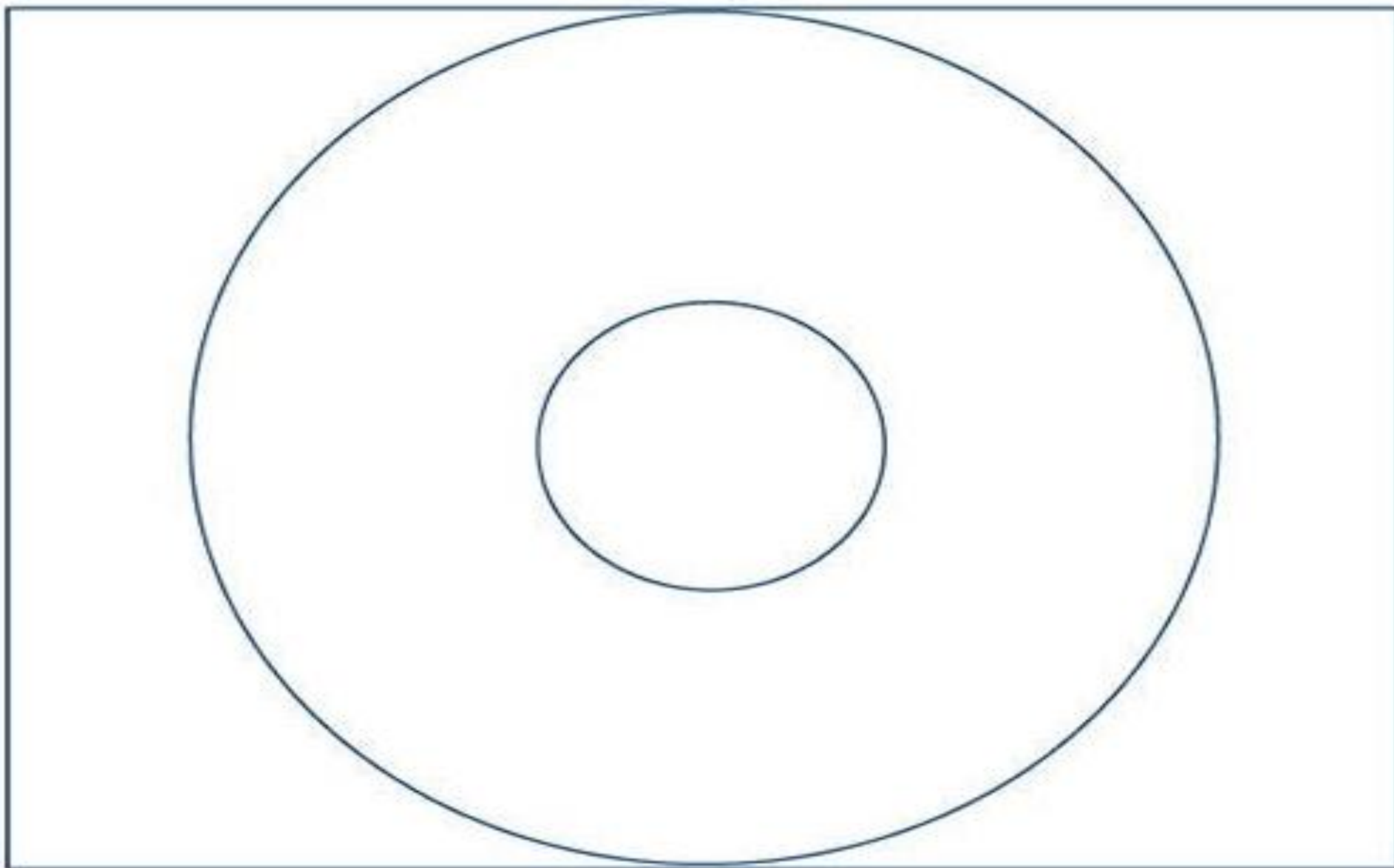
1. How many syllables are in the word?

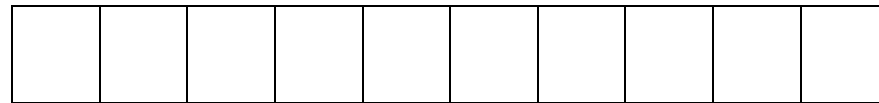

Colour $\frac{1}{10}$



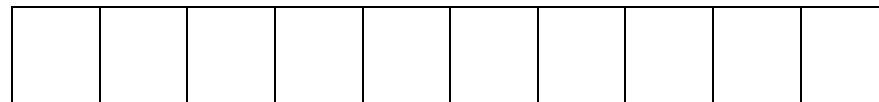
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Colour $\frac{3}{10}$

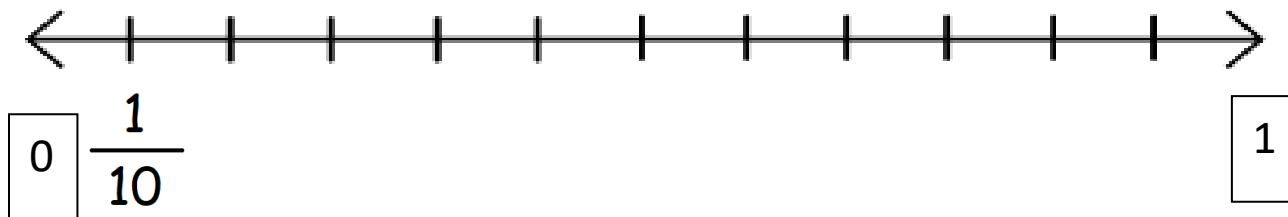
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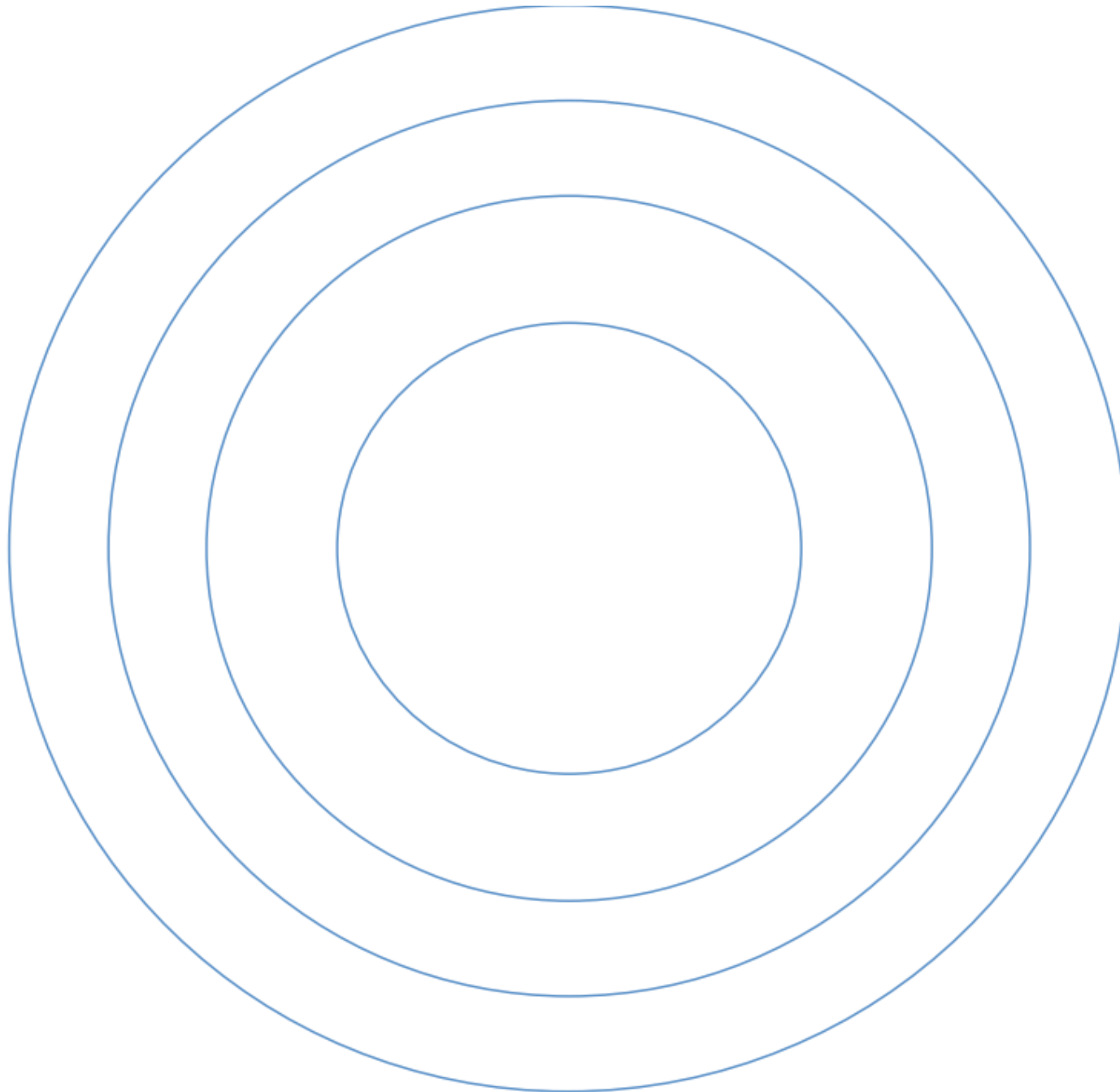
Colour $\frac{9}{10}$
